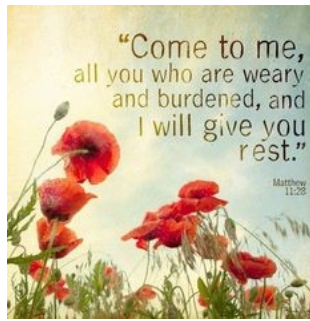

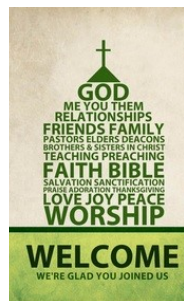
Daily Mass begins next Tuesday, September 13th at 6pm. Please join us.
