Liturgical Note from Father William.....

Christmastide ends in the Extraordinary Form calendar on Sunday January 8th and in the General Roman Calendar (current vernacular calendar) on January 9th with the Feast of the Baptism of Our Lord. The General Roman Calendar begins with Ordinary Time or time throughout the year with the first week of Ordinary Time from Tuesday the 10th of January. Extraordinary Form calendar refers to this period of time as "time after Epiphany." The color of this season is green, the color of life and growth. The last feast connected with Christmas in both versions of the Roman Calendar is February 2nd, The Presentation of Jesus in the Temple (Candle Mass). On February 3rd, the Christmas tree and the Manger will be removed from the Church. On March 1st, Ash Wednesday will begin Lent.
