I am also gratified that many offered help to set up, serve and take down after the Reception last Friday night following the Carol Service and Benediction; very different from last year - another change for the better. These things made a living community of our Parish. Today it is our joy to see a whole family enter the Church. Henry Swindle (himself already Baptized) and his wife Kelly and their sons Henry IV (Eli) and Joshua will receive the Sacraments at the 11am Mass for the first time and become part of our parish family.
