40 Days For Life is a serious and godly initiative. The Nashville observance will begin in our Church with 6pm Mass on Tuesday, February 13th and it will be followed by a candlelight vigil at 7pm outside Planned Parenthood (412 Dr. DB Todd Blvd.) A day of prayer from 7am-7pm will continue over 40 Days to Sunday March 25(Palm Sunday). 40 Days for Life campaigns across the USA and around the world have generated measurable life-saving results: more than 13,900 babies have been reported saved from abortion; 170 abortion workers have quite their jobs and 90 abortion facilities closed. See the 40daysforlife.com/Nashville website for more information. It is hoped that our Parish will be at the forefront during Lent– the 40 Days for Life– as we pray for the forgotten little ones.
