## SUNDAY OF DIVINE MERCY

APRIL 8, 2018

*Dominica in Albis in Octava Paschae*  
 ~ I. classis

**Fr. William Writes:** This Sunday has several names. The oldest is "the Octave Day of Easter." In the mind of the Church, Easter Day lasts a week. Every day of the week is "this Easter Day." It is also known as "Quasi modo Sunday" because the first words of the Latin Entrance Antiphon for Mass are "Quasi Modo" i.e.: "Like newborn infants, you must long for the pure, spiritual milk, that in Him you may grow to Salvation, Alleluia." In more recent years, the name "Divine Mercy Sunday" was added by Pope St. John Paul II. As a loyal son of his native Poland, he gave the church the devotion to the Divine Mercy promulgated by the revelations of Our Lord to St. Faustina. It was on the first Easter Night that Our Lord gave His Apostles the power to forgive and also to retain sins. Easter is about forgiveness, redemption and new life. For the next 6 weeks we continue to ruminate on Resurrection themes. It is a glorious season. In England and Ireland, today is called "Low Sunday," just to make the point that the Octave concludes today. Tomorrow, the Solemnity of the Annunciation of Our Lord is Celebrated. Usually it is celebrated 9 months to the day before Christmas— March 25— but this year, that date was Palm Sunday. So the Annunciation is transferred to the first free day after the Easter Octave. Mass will be provided in both forms: Extraordinary Form (Latin) at noon, and an Extra 6pm Ordinary Form Mass in English. I hope the Feast Day will be well observed.

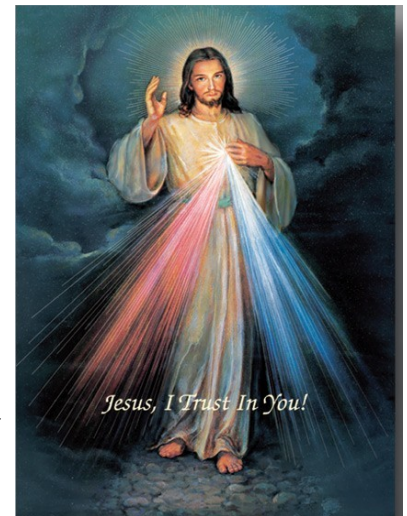
