We would like to welcome Fr. William Fitzgerald as our new Parochial Vicar. Fr. William is a member of the Norbertine Community. He will be living on campus and assisting in the liturgical life of our community. He is also the principal celebrant of the Extraordinary Form Mass. He will begin his duties February 20th.

Ash Wednesday Mass will be celebrated this week at 6:30pm. There will be NO Adoration.

Stations of the Cross will be celebrated Fridays during Lent at 6pm.



Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

For members of the Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may also be taken, but not to equal a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards. If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the "paschal fast" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus, and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily his Resurrection.
