Fr. William Writes: Keeping the Church Tidy: it was said of Our Lord, "zeal for God's house consumes Him." The liturgy for the Dedication of a Church calls a church building "The House of God" and "The gate of heaven." This House of God we have inherited from generations past deserves to be kept clean and tidy. I ask that bulletin sheets be returned to the table at the back of the Church and not left floating around the pews. I ask that the missalettes and missals be stacked at the end of the pews after Mass. Believe it or not, this week on Monday morning two Starbucks paper cups were found under pews- "House of God?" "Gate of heaven?"
