Fr. William writes: It's time I return for a few days to Saint Michael's Abbey, my home base, in Silverado, Orange County, CA. I leave for an absence of 9 days on Thursday 1st March and arrive back in Nashville early in the morning on Saturday 10th March when I will celebrate the Latin 9.00am Mass. On the **First Friday, March 2**, there will be no Extraordinary Form Latin Mass, but there will be the usual First Friday morning Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament from 10.00am to 10.45am with an Ordinary Form English Mass at 11am. The rest of the schedule for Masses both Latin and English will remain the same. I am grateful to Father Benedict O'Cinnsealaigh for covering the daily Masses in English, Confessions, and Stations of the Cross and Fr. Cristiano Nunes for the Extraordinary Form Masses on Saturday 3rd, Sunday 4th, and Monday 5th March. I am very much looking forward to seeing my Abbot and Confreres, especially meeting the new Postulants and Novices who have entered since I was last there.

40 Days For Life continues in earnest for the next 36 days. 7am-7pm people will pray outside Planned Parenthood(412 Dr. DB Todd Blvd.) Our particular Parish day is Thursday.
